Footnote (2): Conversion from Urban and Built-up Land is primarily due to a lack of sufficient infrastructure and the use of detailed digital imagery to delineate more distinct urban boundaries. Examples include portions of the Downtown Railyards awaiting development, abandoned and demolished military structures at McClellan Airport, and the closure of Lawrence Links golf course in Antelope.
