## Section 3010. Eligibility

A real estate appraisal pursuant to Public Resources Code section 10260 must be completed prior to-acting upon any grant application the disbursement of any funding under the a California Farmland Conservancy Program-involving grant for the acquisition of interests in real property. The cost of the appraisal is to be borne by the applicant. However, if the applicant is successful in obtaining a grant, the cost of the appraisal shall be considered a direct cost pursuant to Public Resources Code section 10231 and may be reimbursed at the discretion of the Director, based upon the fiscal considerations of a specific project.
